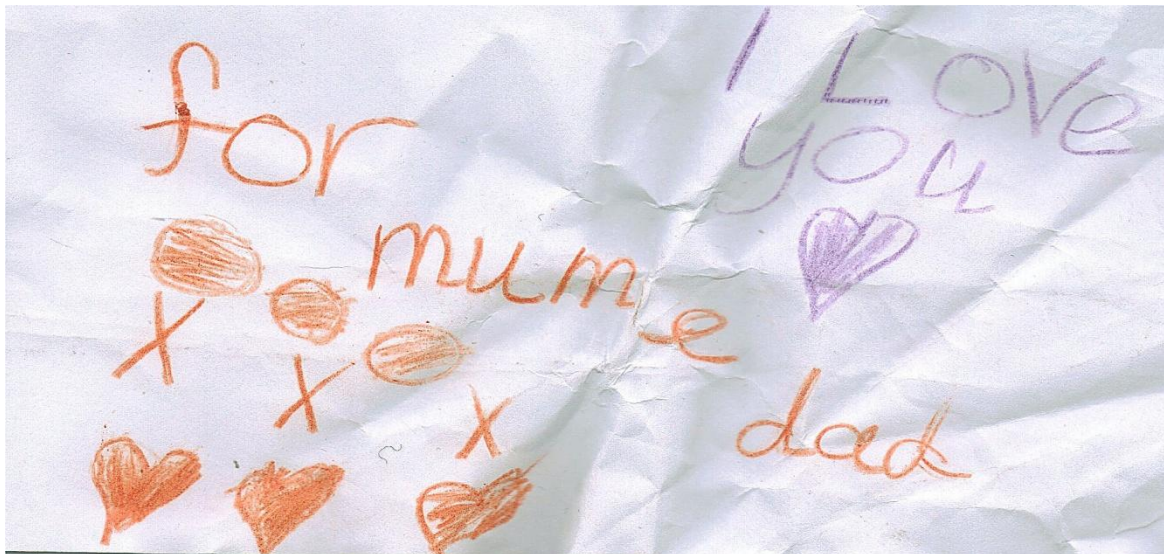


Mummy & Daddy's Poem
